Dear Parents of K'Ton Ton Campers,

Shalom! Welcome to Center Day Camps. We're happy to have your child as a camper this summer. We are looking forward to so much fun and activities. Here are a few things that will help us provide you great service: (Please read carefully as there are variances from general camp.)

1. **LABEL ALL CLOTHING AND OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S FULL NAME.**
2. Send your child to camp in a bathing suit (under clothing). Send dry underwear, a towel, **water shoes** (to be used on the playground when we run through the sprinkler) and a plastic bag for wet things in a backpack. We will swim each morning and use the Berlin playground with a water feature when possible.
3. **Apply sunscreen at home in the morning** to give it time to activate. Full-day campers may bring sunscreen and/or insect repellent to leave at camp for use as needed. We will reapply after lunch or for outdoor activities. **(See #4 for medication card requirement, if necessary)**
4. A **medication card** must be filled out for all prescriptions, over-the-counter medications, lotions and creams. Each must be in its original container, must have the child's name and can only be administered for the recommended dosage (you will find medication cards enclosed).
5. If your child is a half-day camper, pick-up is at 12:10 p.m. at the canopy entrance to the Pitt Child Development Center. You must sign your child out with camp staff. If the person who regularly picks up is someone other than the parent, his/her name must be listed on the Child Information Record sheet under "may be released to." We will request identification if we are not familiar with the person who is picking up. Park in a designated parent spot and walk over to the canopy. **There is no parking or standing adjacent to the building.** At 3:30 p.m. and for all extended care, drop-off or pick-up will be in the Pitt Child Development Center pick-up room. Park in a designated parent spot and come into the Pitt CDC entrance at the back. Extended care ends promptly at 6 p.m. A late fee will be assessed after that time.
6. Please sign any permission slips and forms sent home with your child and return promptly. Field trips are arranged for the last Monday of each session.
7. **A kosher-dairy lunch is provided for all full-day preschool campers. We are a nut-free camp environment. Do not send food from home.**
8. A short rest time is required by our licensing agency for any child in our care for more than five hours. This is a quiet rest and not necessarily a nap; however, many children do fall asleep. Please send a **small** pillow and blanket for your child to keep at camp. We will send them home each Friday for laundering.
9. Full-day campers will need to bring a set of extra clothing to leave at camp for the summer.
10. Even though you have turned in a health form to the camp office, please notify the K'Ton Ton staff **in writing** of any serious food, insect or medication allergy your child may have.
